Winters Drummer House

In the early 1900s traveling salesmen were known as drummers. These drummers would travel from location to location with, in most cases, a miniature version of their goods. These drummers would set up their wares and retailers from the surrounding area would come, place their orders, the order would be sent to the manufacturers warehouse and the merchandise would soon arrive on the train. The railroad servicing Winters was the Abilene & Southern Railroad.
